








We will not soon be over the



The Ambassador Within . . .

It was late 1945. The atomic bomb had just ended World War II. A jubilant America was celebrating the Allied victories over Germany and Japan. Mothers rejoiced to have their sons home, thoughts of world peace now seemed possible, and the greatest war effort ever known to mankind was beginning to unwind.

At the same time, in the United States' Pacific Northwest, the pastor of a small church group was trying to build a new evangelistic effort. In twelve years, this preacher, with his wife at his side, had built a small, yet loyal, listening audience for his Sunday morning radio program. Starting out as a broadcast church service, this program had developed into a news analysis of global events, from a Bible prophecy perspective. It produced excellent ratings for radio stations, and the word was spreading. Suddenly, daily broadcasting opened its door on 2 superstations. Not one to shy away from a seemingly impossible challenge, the 53-year old minister soon found himself flooded with listener response. Realizing that he could not continue pastoring, writing and broadcasting without specially-trained manpower, Herbert W. Armstrong, in December, 1945, first discussed with his wife, Loma, the idea of starting a college.

The rest is history. Through sheer faith in Jesus Christ, and not much else, Ambassador was born in the fall of 1947. Four students, eight instructors, a building, and a mission — a 50-year mission that would touch millions of lives with the gospel of the Kingdom of God.

The story of Ambassador is inextricably entwined with that of the Worldwide Church of God. Without Ambassador, the minute church, with only a handful of faithful, could never have become a global work.

Ambassador became the backbone and muscle of one of the most astounding miracles in the history of creation.

High points? On the organizational level: The World Tomorrow sponsored by Ambassador became the largest purchaser of radio time in America, heard over 300 stations worldwide. The World Tomorrow Television achieved the second highest sustained rating of any religious program, viewed over 260 stations. The Plain Truth Magazine, published in 7 languages, achieved a readership in excess of 20 million in 196 countries. Educational materials, estimated in the tens of millions of copies, were provided for the asking. For twenty years, Ambassador Auditorium earned critical acclaim for setting an unsurpassed standard of excellence in the performing arts. On the personal level: Foreign projects employed Ambassador students and graduates who taught true values to those of other cultures. Community outreaches benefitted from Ambassador volunteers. The list is endless: Archeological excavations. Intercollegiate sports. Music and the Arts. Public radio broadcasting. High academic standards. Regional accreditation. National recognition. Life-long friendships. Marriages and families.

For fifty unbelievable years, Ambassador has remained true to its original mission. It has held a lamp to guide the way for young and old, rich and poor, Christian and non-Christian, to find and live the true values. It was God who first flashed the idea of Ambassador into Herbert Armstrong's mind, and it was God who developed Ambassador into a global influence far beyond what its physical resources alone could ever produce. And it is that same all-knowing, all-powerful, Sustainer of the

universe who has shown that Ambassador's 50-year mission as an organization is accomplished. The physical, corporate effort called Ambassador University is no longer needed.

God has used the gifts and talents of thousands of people over the years to create Ambassador. And each of us should take humble, yet genuine pride in what we've accomplished under Christ's direction, for God can truly say "Well done, good and faithful servants."

Therefore, we remember and honor all of those whose positive contributions made Ambassador possible. Beginning with Loma and Herbert Armstrong, and including administrators, teachers, students, contributors and partners in prayer, we have all been coworkers in a modern-day miracle.

Ambassador University may close its doors, but its mission continues on. It becomes an individual one — our own personal mission. No longer facilitated through corporate resources and programs, it will be accomplished through Ambassadors living successful personal lives, utilizing their individual talents and resources, and being guided by their working relationships with Jesus Christ.

All that was and is Ambassador will continue as . . . *The Ambassador Within*.

The Ambassador Within each of us will shine as a personal light for others seeking true values.

The Ambassador Within each of us will set a personal example for others, of truly successful living.

The Ambassador Within each of us will guide us personally to love, help and serve our fellow man.

As we go forward, let us carry on our Father's work — the work of Ambassador University — inspired, motivated and empowered by . . .

. . . *The Ambassador Within*.


Freshmen reception was held in the Fieldhouse. Here the freshmen dressed their best to meet Mr. Tkach and the faculty.




For all Ambassador has given me, I feel privileged to have been a part of this 50th Anniversary Envoy.
