


Introduction

The Pasadena Campus

Ambassador College, Pasadena, occupies 45 acres in the heart of the Rose Bowl City's finest residential district, adjacent to famous Orange Grove Boulevard. The college first opened its doors on October 8, 1947. The then recently acquired two-and-a-half acre Fowler estate became "campus" for the eight faculty members and four students that first autumn! 























Physical Education

Each club meets once a month with menu, decorations, songs, and entertainment depicting the native lands of that particular language. All speaking must be done in the foreign tongue.












Graduation Day-1970







The Bricket Mood! Campus Ambassador College became an international institution during the fall of 1960 when a second campus-Ambassador U.K.-opened its doors. It is located in the outskirts of a small, quiet English village called Bricket Wood, on a private estate built in the early part of this century by Sir David Yule of East India Company fame. New college buildings now include the Gymnasium Complex which was chosen by the British Olympics Committee to represent the nation's sports facilities in a photographic display in the 1968 Olympic Games in Mexico City, Its 200 acres are situated in the "green belt" surrounding historic London. The M. 1 motorway, passing nearby, gives easy access to the cultural advantages available in London and Britain's other principal cities as well as providing the link for a quick hop to any of the key cities on the continent. A student body representing up to thirty different nations helps create a close-knit family atmosphere with a distinct international flavor

The Big Sandly Campus

The third Ambassador College campus located at Big Sandy is nestled in the idyllic East Texas countryside-100 miles from Dallas. Unfettered by city sprawl, the rustic 4000-acre complex is able to implement a program of agricultural research including experiments in soil development and crop and livestock improvement. This campus was established in September, 1964, with 108 pioneering students. The completion of the Master Plan will provide the capacity for 550 students. Here, just as at the Pasadena and Bricket Wood campuses, the same goals of character and culture are carefully pursued. Visitors are greeted at the college entrance by five sculptured bronze "Swans in Flight" which gracefully rise out of a 120-foot mirror pool. The building program has provided new dormitories, classrooms, an ultra-modern dining hall, and a field house-with more structures on the drawing boards. Natural springs and streams, in addition to beautiful Lake Loma-teeming with largemouth black bass, crappie and bream-lend a sparkling and refreshing touch of outdoors to our newest campus.

Displayed to the right are the kind of peaceful, invigorating, natural surroundings so conducive to a healthy body and mind, and which are characteristic of our beautiful Big Sandy Campus.
